

# Have you received gender-affirming healthcare as a transgender, non-binary or gender nonconforming person?

Participants are invited for interviews as part of a new research study “[Transnationalizing Gender, Medicine, and Standardization: Gender-Affirming Healthcare in Thailand and the United States.](#)” The goal of this transnational research is to understand how transgender and gender nonconforming (TGNC) people and medical professionals think about and use various guidelines in decision-making for gender-affirming healthcare.

## Who are we looking for?

This study is open to people who identify as transgender, gender nonconforming, or non-binary and live in the U.S. or Thailand. Participants must be at least 18 years old.

## What will you be asked to do?

Participants will be interviewed about their experiences with medical professionals in accessing and planning gender-affirming healthcare. Interviews are expected to last between 30 minutes and 2 hours in length. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all interviews will take place via phone or video call. Participation will be kept confidential.
