

# Do you provide gender-affirming healthcare to transgender, non-binary, or gender nonconforming patients?

Participants are invited for interviews as part of a new research study “[Transnationalizing Gender, Medicine, and Standardization: Gender-Affirming Healthcare in Thailand and the United States.](#)” The goal of this transnational research is to understand how transgender and gender nonconforming (TGNC) people and healthcare providers think about and use various guidelines in decision-making for gender-affirming care.

## What will you be asked to do?

Interviews are expected to last between 30 minutes and 2 hours in length. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all interviews will take place via phone or video call.
